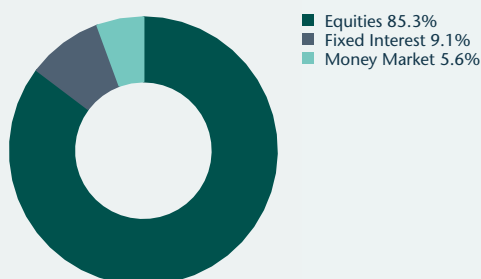

Composition of Portfolio by Sector



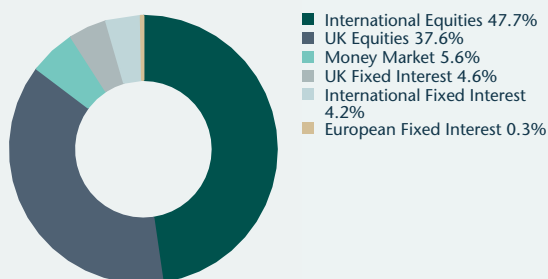
