<p>The SL BNY Mellon Multi-Asset Diversified Return Pension Fund invests primarily in the BNY Mellon Multi-Asset Diversified Return Fund. The aim of the BNY Mellon Multi-Asset Diversified Return Fund is summarised below.</p> <p>To achieve long-term capital growth over a period of at least 5 years from a portfolio diversified across a range of assets. The Fund is managed to seek a return in excess of cash (SONIA 30 (day compounded)) +3% per annum over five years before fees. In doing so, it aims to achieve a positive return on a rolling three year basis (meaning a period of three years, no matter which day you start on). 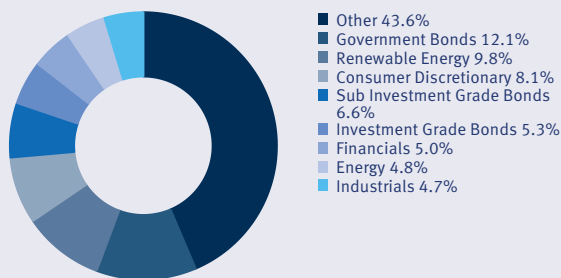

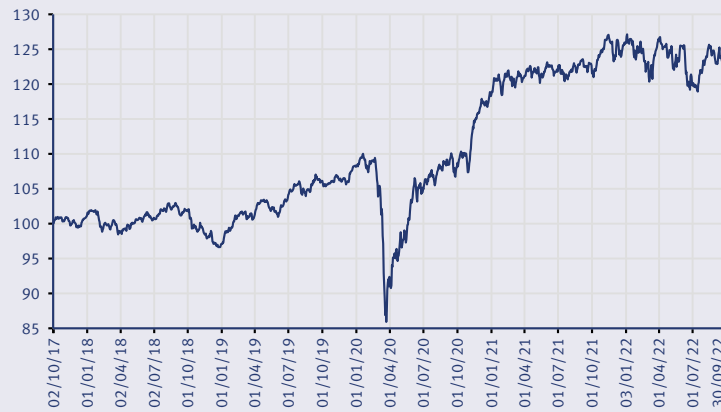
