| <p>The SL Blackrock ACS Continental European Equity Tracker Pension Fund invests primarily in the BlackRock ACS Continental European Equity Tracker Fund. The aim of the BlackRock ACS Continental European Equity Tracker Fund is summarised below.</p> <p>The Fund is a sub-fund of BlackRock Authorised Contractual Scheme I taking the form of a co-ownership scheme. As a consequence of this, the Fund may be treated as tax transparent for the purpose of income and/or capital gains by relevant taxing jurisdictions. Each investor should take appropriate professional advice as to the tax treatment of their investment in the Fund. Investors in the Fund must be Eligible Investors as defined in the Fund's prospectus and must have completed all relevant documentation prior to the purchase of units in the Fund. The Fund aims to provide a return on your investment (generated through an increase to the value of the assets held by the Fund and/or income received from those assets) by tracking closely the performance of the FTSE Developed Europe ex UK Index, the Fund's benchmark index (the "Benchmark Index"). 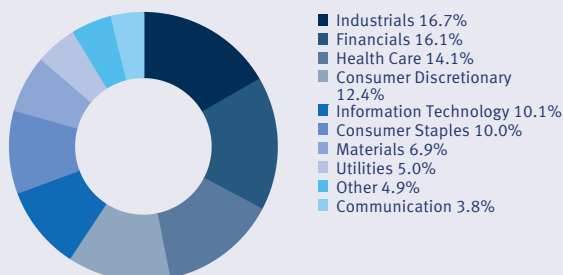

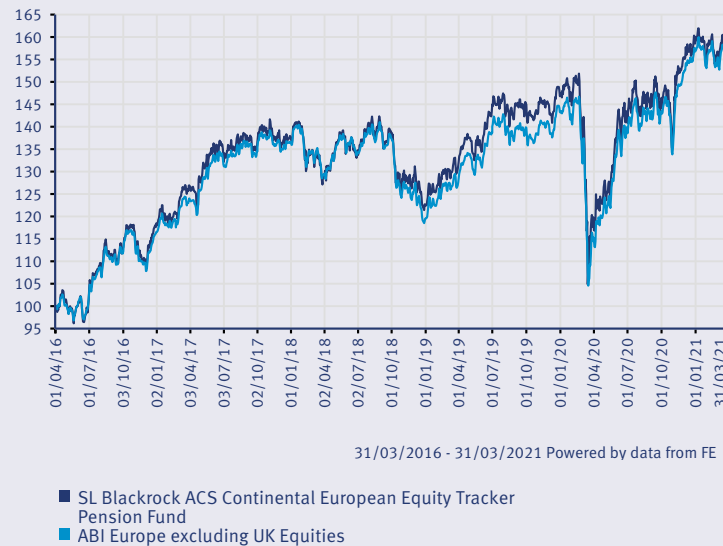
