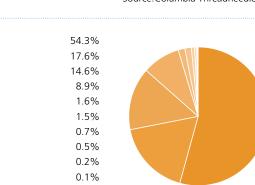

The majority of the portfolio is invested in equities, with an emphasis on Europe, which produced a modest positive return in Q2. Investors were cheered by a cut in interest rates by the European Central Bank and the strong performance of technology stocks. By far the biggest portfolio adjustments were to increase global equities while scaling back the regional US equity allocation. Given the elevated valuations of US technology stocks, we preferred to broaden exposure to US quality-growth companies by adding to the Global Select Fund, as well as the Global Focus Fund. We also reduced equities in Asia, the UK and Japan, but added to European government bonds. Additionally, within the European and US equity allocations, we adjusted exposure to different strategies.

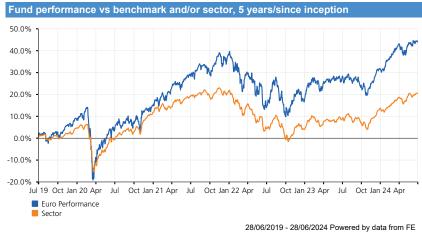
