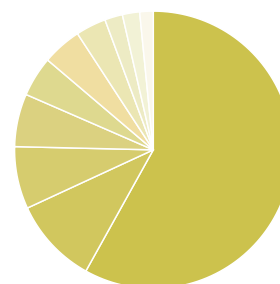

Fund objective

The fund aims to provide relatively high income with the possibility of capital growth. The fund may invest its net assets directly in onshore China bonds listed or traded on any eligible market in China. The fund has the freedom to invest outside its principal geographies, market sectors, industries or asset classes. Investments may be made in currencies other than the fund's reference currency. Exposure to currencies may be hedged, for example with currency forward contracts. The fund's reference currency is the currency used for reporting and may be different from the currency of denomination of the investments. The fund can invest in bonds issued by governments, companies and other bodies. The fund may invest in assets directly or achieve exposure indirectly through other eligible means including derivatives. The fund can use derivatives with the aim of risk or cost reduction or to generate additional capital or income, including for investment purposes, in line with the fund's risk profile. Income earned by the fund is reinvested in additional shares or paid to shareholders on request. Shares can usually be bought and sold each business day of the fund. The return you will receive depends on the performance of the underlying assets. The fund will invest in bonds issued in global markets to maximize performance measured in US Dollars. The fund will invest less than 30% directly and/or indirectly in onshore China fixed income securities on an aggregated basis. The fund is actively managed. The Investment Manager will, when selecting investments for the fund and for the purposes of monitoring risk, reference {{SHARE_CLASS_BENCHMARK}} (the "Index"). The fund's performance can be assessed against its Index. The Investment Manager has a wide range of discretion relative to the Index. While the fund will hold assets that are components of the Index, it may also invest in issuers, sectors, countries and security types that are not included in, and that have different weightings from, the Index in order to take advantage of investment opportunities.

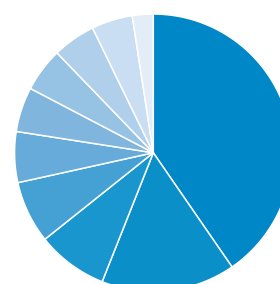

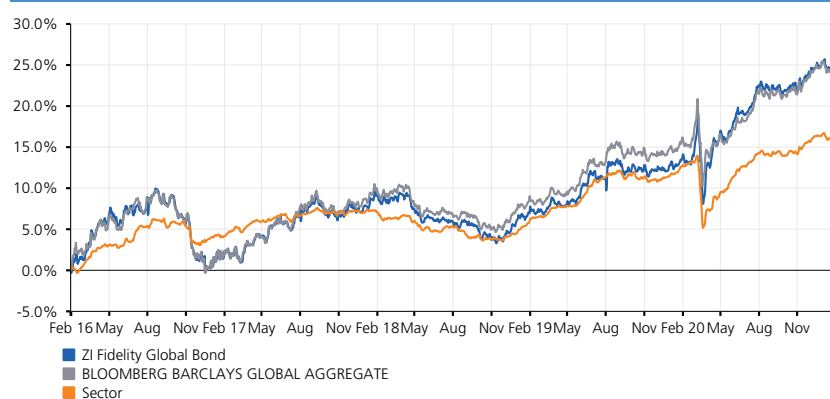
