Fund objective

This fund aims to provide a balance of income and capital growth, however there may be some risk to capital. The fund invests mainly in a range of collective investment vehicles and securities managed by selected fund managers. The fund will comprise a mixture of income generating assets and assets with scope for capital growth in real terms. The fund may use different asset classes, with investment mainly in equities and fixed-interest with no long-term bias to either class. 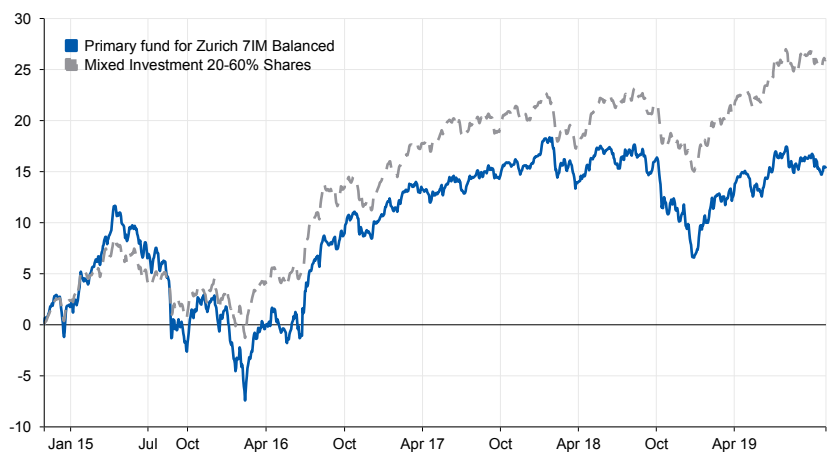
