Up to 20% of the Fund's assets may be invested outside Emerging Market Countries including developed economies and / or other emerging markets.

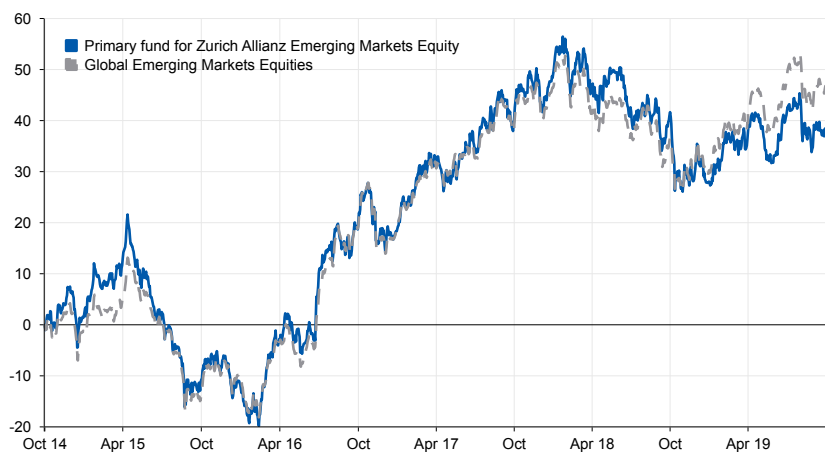
