The fund will seek to achieve its investment objective by investing at least 70-75% of its total assets directly and indirectly in equities and equity-related securities of companies incorporated in, or exercising the predominant part of their economic activity in Europe, or quoted or traded on the stock exchanges in Europe.

The fund currently invests in the Baring European Select and Baring European Growth funds.
