### Fund features

This fund invests in assets which have the potential to produce superior longer term returns. Over some periods of time there can be significant falls, as well as rises, in the value of your investment.

The fund is managed by Threadneedle Asset Management Limited. Other fund managers manage components of the fund, the most significant being BlackRock with typically 15 to 20 percent of the fund's assets held in their passive managed unit trusts.
