### Fund objective

To achieve medium to long term capital growth by investing in a spread of investments both by asset type and by economy (primarily the UK but also globally). The equity and property elements of the fund are invested via Zurich Assurance Ltd Pension funds with the balance invested in gilts, deposits, money market instruments and other fixed interest investments to provide liquidity, security and income.

### Fund features

This fund invests in assets which have the potential to produce above average longer term returns. Over some periods of time there can be sharp falls, as well as rises, in the value of your investment.

The fund is managed by Threadneedle Asset Management Limited. Other fund managers manage components of the fund, the most significant being BlackRock with typically 15 to 20 percent of the fund's assets held in their passive managed unit trusts.
